Note to parents

The words for the sentences can be found on the pdf file Sight words we continue starting with number 16 ending at number 30 for the week. The file is under media documents on the group. Please keep in mind the structure of the sentence and the number of words.

Character stories will be send to the group learners will have to read the story and answer the questions on specific days.

Verbs and adverbs worksheet will be send to the group and learners will need to draw the table in the books and write the words under the correct heading no need to cut and paste them, parents who have made printouts can do so on the worksheet. It is titled verbs and adverbs

Phonics worksheet will be send to the groups learners will need to write down the entire word in their books or on paper those that make printouts can write on the worksheets, these worksheets will be titled Phonics the ( ie, y and igh) sound and Phonics the ( au and aw) sound respectively.

Arts and craft- learners will need an A4 white sheet/A4 coloured sheet ( not a very dark one)/or normal paper and write a short clear message of hope to everyone fighting the coronavirus. They should make this poster colourful, but the message should stand out from the decoration. A picture must be taken of the learner holding the poster and sent to the group. Parents if you do not want pictures of your child taken you are most welcome to just send the poster without your child as I intend on making a video with it.

Work that is done during the lockdown will need to be kept safely and neatly.

Fridays are reserved for marking and reading. Every Fridays I will send out a story that learners will have to read allowed to an adult please parents you do not need to print these out as they are for practice purposes.
