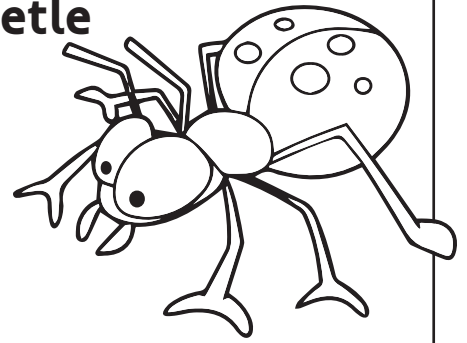

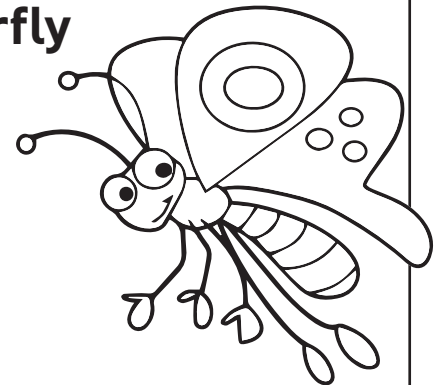

Can you hear the rhyming words?

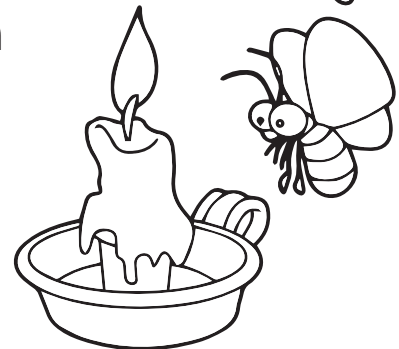
**Little brown beetle, little brown beetle

I've been crawling all around.**



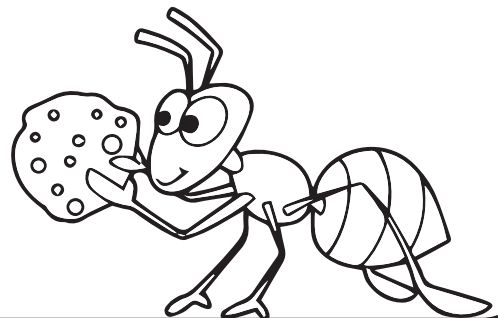
**Small red butterfly, small red butterfly
