PLEASE NOTE

- Learners MUST have extra masks every day.
- Learners must bring wet wipes to class to wipe their table and their hands.
- All classes must sit the full duration of the paper. No learner will be allowed to leave the classroom early OR remain on or around the school premises. Learners must be collected after writing their papers to ensure examination integrity and appropriate social distancing.
- No sharing of stationary or borrowing from teachers or other grades. Bring extra pens to write with.
- No electronic devices allowed on any learner in the classroom. It can be left switched off on the teacher's table.
- Late comers will not be allowed extra time.
- When a session is over and all exam papers collected, the teacher will escort the entire class off the premises immediately.
- Learners must be at school at the normal gates for screening before 7h00 for the First Session
- Learners reporting for the second session must be at school 20 minutes before the starting time of the paper. They must report at the teacher car gate for screening and NOT at any other entrance.
- Grade 12 NSC learners must be at school not later than 8h20. They must use the car gate and wait for Mrs. Lourens to collect them as a group and escort them to their exam location.
- Learners not leaving the school ground or surrounding areas will be seated in a separate classroom with invigilation until 13h30.
- Text books for the specific subject must be handed in before the commencement of the exam paper.
- If a text book is lost or damaged, learners must first pay the R250 per text book at the office and produce the receipt to the teacher invigilating as well as the subject teacher.
